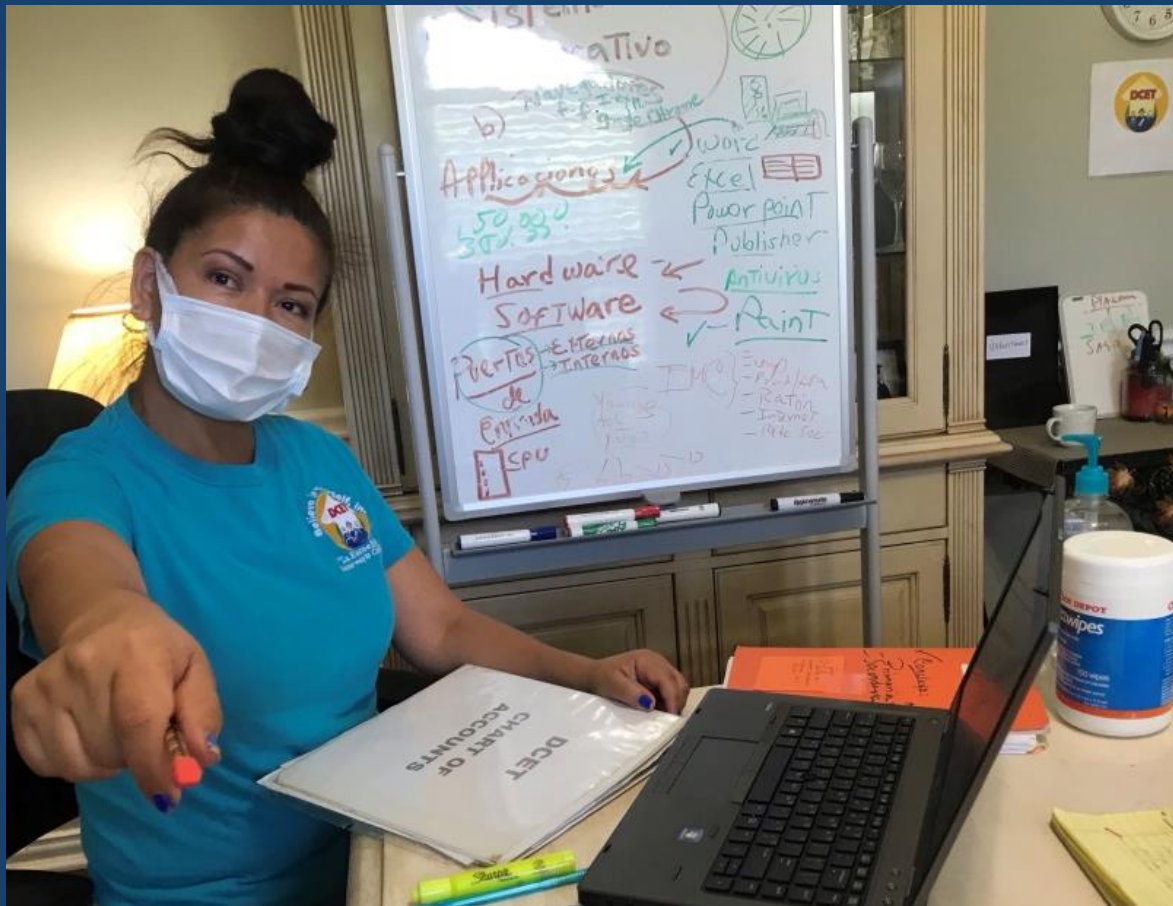

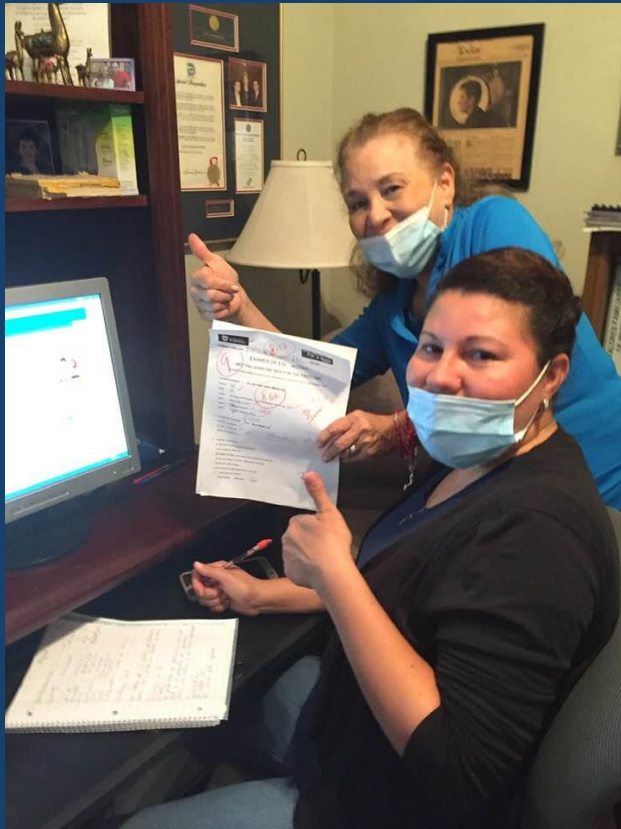

DCET serves as a bridge to help families to fully participate in the variety of health, human service and education programs available in order for them to become productive members of society.



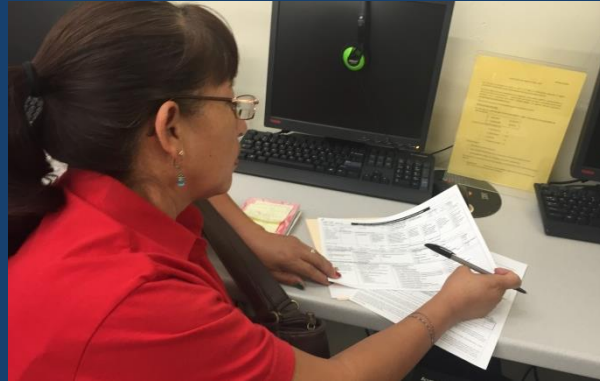

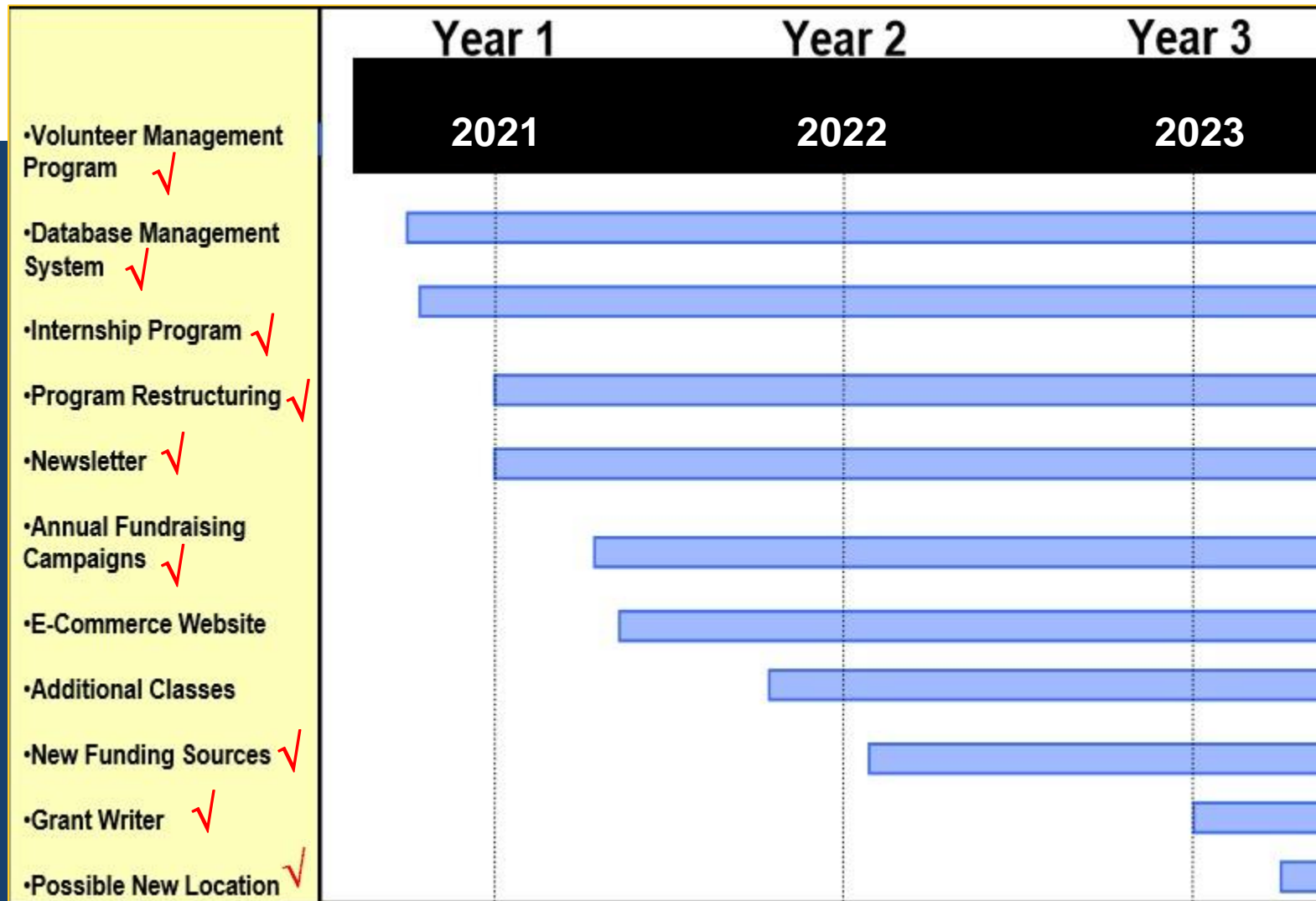

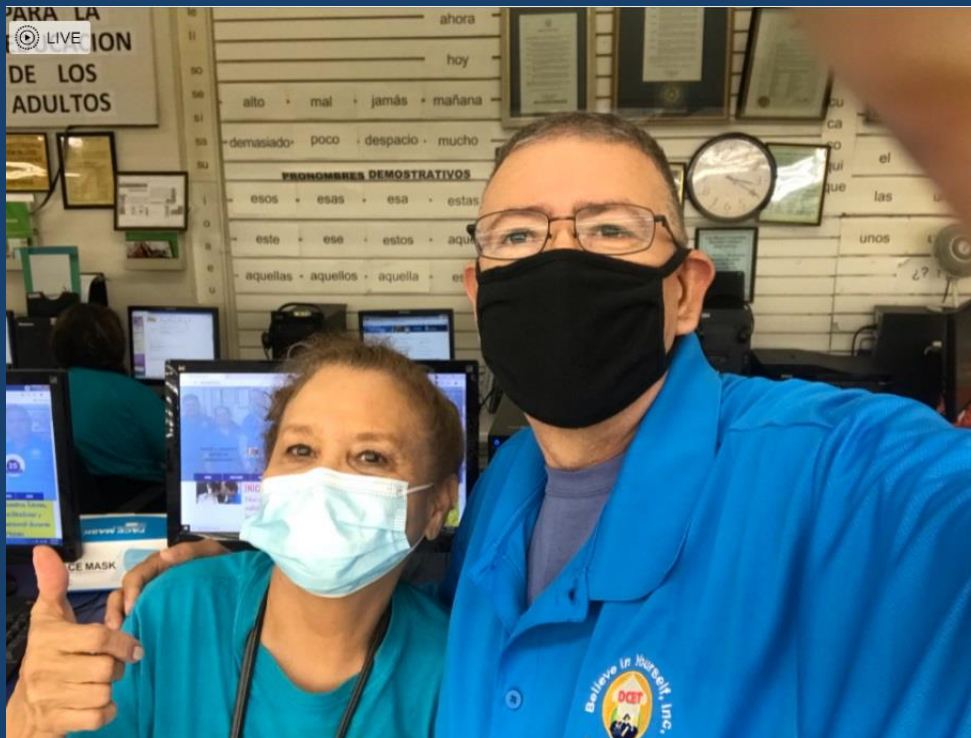
During the year 2021, volunteers and Board of Directors contributed to a total of 1,220 hours of time to DCET

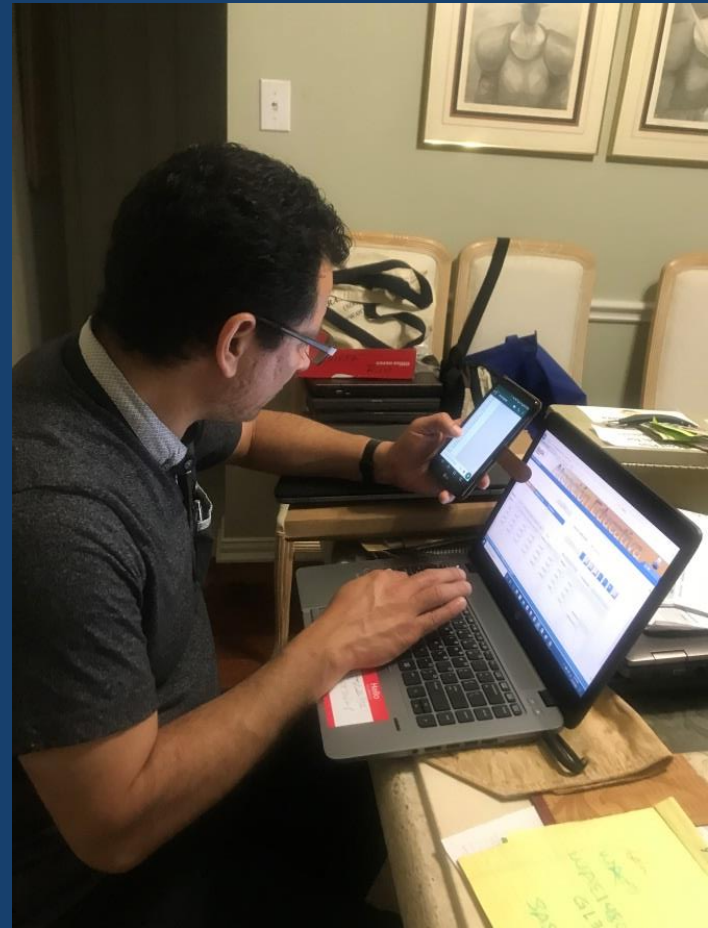

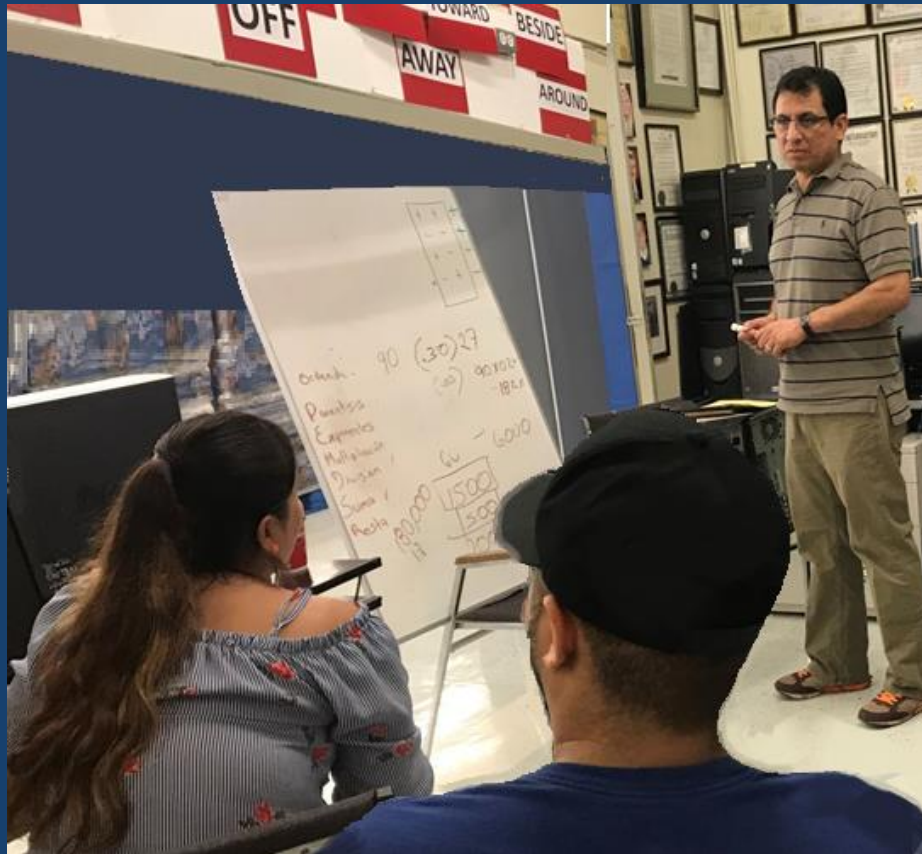

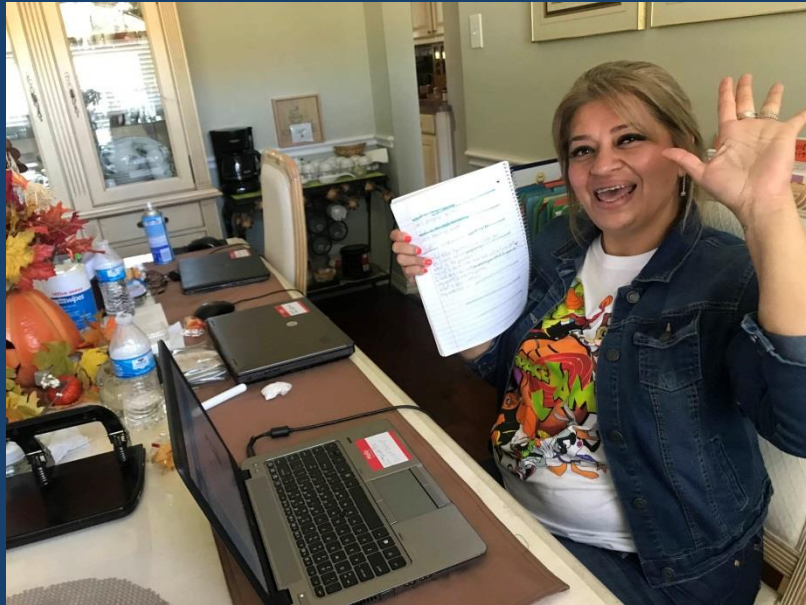
English Basic for Daily Life 14 modules curricula from **TEC of Monterrey University** is the Level 1 ESL course students go through at DCET.

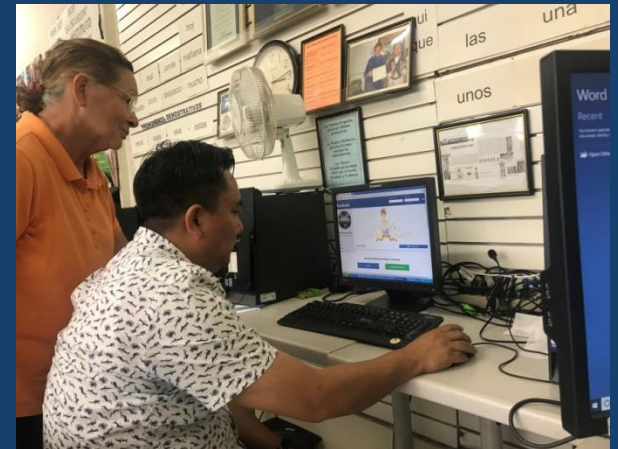


# DCET INCREASES ENGLISH FLUENCY & LITERACY AMONG ADULTS

1. A Language section where applicants have to read, speak, and write in English.
2. A Civics portion with 100 possible questions.

*Applicants are asked 10 questions and must get six right*
